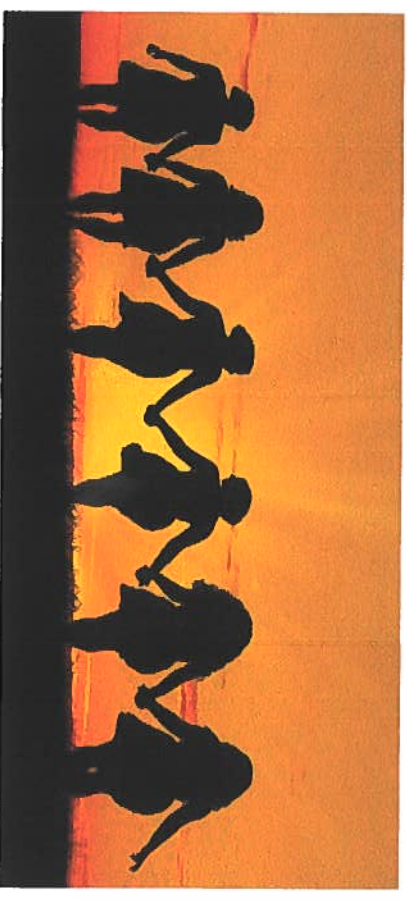

Shoebbox gifts are collected all over the World: Australia, Austria, Canada, Finland, Germany, New Zealand, S Korea, Spain, Switzerland, U.K., and U.S. Over 11 million were collected in 2022, 9.4 million of those coming from the U.S. Almost 500,000 volunteers are involved in this effort, the largest Christmas project of its kind has collected more than 198 million shoebbox gifts to children in more than 70 countries and territories. Statistics show that of those who have received shoebboxes, half have attended classes to hear about Jesus' love for them and the salvation He offers, and half of those receive Him into their lives. Many times, the shoebbox gift is the first gift the child has ever received!
